WHAT IS THE LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD?

The Amusement Industry's Lifetime Achievement Award is a recognition award presented to honor an individual for their outstanding service and positive impact on the coin-op industry.

WHO CAN NOMINATE CANDIDATES?

Any AAMA Member may nominate candidates. AAMA's Executive Committee and President will evaluate the nominees and their criteria.

WHAT IS THE CRITERIA?

The nominee must have a minimum of 15 years of service in the amusement industry. The person should be a humanitarian, who has demonstrated his/her kindness and concern for others and who has contributed his/her expertise to help others achieve success. The nominee should possess innovative and creative qualities of producing new ideas and innovations to benefit his/her peers and the amusement industry. The characteristics of the nominee must reflect a combination of ethical strength, as well as emotional, intellectual and moral qualities that distinguish the individual as having an outstanding reputation.
